Introduction

During the academic year 2024–25, the school gave equal importance to scholastic and co-scholastic development, focusing on academic excellence, values, skills, and holistic growth. The consistent efforts of students, teachers, management, parents, and well-wishers have resulted in remarkable achievements and meaningful learning experiences.

Academic Excellence – Class 10 Board Results

The excellent performance of students in the 2025 Class 10 Board Examination was celebrated on June 30th in a function titled Vijayamruth, inaugurated by ISRO Deputy Director Sri M. N. Subramanian. Kumari Sreenanda V. M. emerged as the school topper. Bhadra Bijoy, Karthik Shaman, Nived Ranjit Kumar, Jishnenth V P, Krishnamruta Biju secured 90% and above, while the remaining students achieved 80% and above. Students who secured full marks in Sanskrit, Malayalam, and Science were specially honoured. Teachers Smt Smitha N. R., Smt Lathika K.S, Smt Simi K. S and Smt Shiji K. U. were honoured for their dedicated teaching that enabled students to secure 100 out of 100.

Bharatheeya Vidya Niketan Educational Meet

In the academic year 2025, the Bharatiya Vidya Niketan Educational Meet was hosted by our school on June 28th. On this occasion, the institution was honoured with the Academic Excellence Award, recognising its consistent success and valuable contribution to the field of education.

Robotics and AI Education

To introduce students to the world of Robotics and Artificial Intelligence, the school established a Robotics Lab with the motto “Empowering Innovation and Inspiring the Future.” The lab was inaugurated on December 9th by Mr. Kiran Vijay, Trainer at Edtech Platform GENxmy the Tech platform.

Clubs and Co-Scholastic Activities

For the holistic development of students, various clubs were introduced based on subjects, languages, and important days.

- a. English Club (GLITZ) was conducted on June 18th, helping students improve reading skills and effective language usage.
- b. Reading Club (Vayana vasantham) was celebrated on June 19th, encouraging creativity, expression, and language development.
- c. Cultural Club (Sadgamaya) was conducted on July 10th, 2025, to promote cultural values and traditions.
- d. Maths Club (Mathera) was organised on July 16th, 2025, to enhance logical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- e. Social Science Club was celebrated on August 15th, fostering social awareness and responsible citizenship and Sanskrit club on August 20, Hindi club on September 25, Malayalam club on November 17 to enhance the usage of language and creativity.

These clubs enhanced students’ communication, interaction, cooperation, leadership qualities, and overall holistic development.

Career Guidance and Student Development

Career guidance and counselling programmes were conducted to help students overcome academic challenges and build confidence. A three-day residential camp was organised from May 20th to 22nd for students from Grade 3 to Grade 10. A one-day follow-up camp was conducted on August 6th for Grades 6 to 10. Special Mathematics support classes for Classes 9 and 10 helped students' clear doubts and learn effective problem-solving techniques. Youth development programmes further strengthened students' life skills.

A Parenting Empowerment Programme was organised for parents and was conducted by the Civil Excise Officer, Sri Muhammad Basil by offering valuable guidance on effective parenting. An awareness programme for Cyber security for the students from STD VIII – STD X.

Sisu Vatika

Sisu Vatika reopened on June 9th with the celebration of Entry Fest. The programme follows the National Curriculum Framework for the foundational stage, focusing on holistic development through activity-based worksheets, classroom activities, games and play-way methods. An orientation class for parents was conducted on June 17th to guide them on early childhood development.

Science Exhibition

School-Level Science Exhibition titled Sphuran-2025 was conducted on July 25th and 26th to enhance scientific thinking and creativity. The exhibition was inaugurated by former DPO Sri Shaiju. P. S. The District-Level Science Exhibition was held from September 16th to 23rd at Sree Rama Krishna Vidyanikethan and Annanya U S of Std Xth and was selected for the State-Level Science Exhibition.

Cultural Activities

Cultural education was actively implemented to nurture creativity and instil Indian values. Celebrations began from June 5th, including Reading Day, International Yoga Day (June 21st), Digvijay Diwas ,Ramayana month,Music Day, Pooja Month, Sanskrit Day and Raksha Bandhan,Deenadayal Jayanthi,Vjayadasami,Geetha Jayanthi etc. Students participated in competitions such as Prabandharajana, Prashnamanch,Aithihasikam related with culture. In district-level competitions a Class 10 student from Kishore Vibhag, Rajalakshmi K and Chaithra from Class 8 secured third position. On December 13th, students participated in Aithihasikam and secured third position.

Sports and Physical Education

We had given equal importance to Sports in the academic year. On July 12th, Mahadevan P. V, Class 9 secured second position in the District Chess Tournament and was selected for the State Level and then to Zonal level. In the District Kabaddi Competition on September 17th, the boys' team secured second position, and five boys and eight girls were selected for the State Level. At the State Athletics Meet on August 30th in Kottayam, students Vinayak N B (Class 7), Sreya M. V. (Class 7), Satvika Santhosh (Class 9), and Abhivanth Rajesh (Class 10) were selected. Abhivanth Rajesh secured third runner-up in the 5000 m walk race. In the Kerala Central School Sports Meet, Vinayak N B (Class 7) secured third position and earned State-level selection.

Educational Tour

An educational tour was organised from October 9th to 12th, 2025 for Classes 9 and 10 to Kodaikanal, Ramakalmedu and nearby places. The tour enhanced experiential learning and broadened students' knowledge through educational exposure.

Parent-Teacher Association (PTA)

The Welfare Council and Mathrubharathi Council together constitute the PTA of the school. Guided by Sri Saran A. V. and Smt Thennal Limin . The PTA actively supports academic and co-curricular programmes and participates in day-to-day school activities, providing strong parental support.
